## **ETI Service Process**

- Transmission/Distribution Questionnaire
- Planning Study Identification of required upgrades
- OOM estimate
- Facility Study (detailed scope and design plan) \$
- Reimbursement agreement
- CCN?
- Begin detailed design and construction
- Agreement for Electric Service



## Rules of Thumb

- Discuss siting of your facilities early in the process
- The higher the required reliability and voltage the higher the cost
- Strive for transmission lines under 1 mile
- Transmission lines over 1 mile may add significant time to the project



# **Case Study**

#### **New Pumping Facility**

- 3 MW load next to existing 138 kV transmission line
- Customer requested transmission service approximate cost \$5 million for turn-in and HS
- ETI was able to serve the load out of an existing substation ~ 4 miles away that had adequate transformer capacity. Saving about \$4 million.
